Introduction

The International Peanut Conference was organized by Kasetsart University, United State Agency for International Development Peanut Collaborative Research Support Program (USAID-Peanut CRSP), University of Georgia (UGA), and the Department of Agriculture Extension (DOAE). The theme of the Conference is “Prospects and Emerging Opportunities for Peanut Quality and Utilization Technology”. The Conference program is also designed to give delegates an insight into technology application in Asian and Pacific countries, in order to enable the successful development, production and marketing of peanut products. Especially, it is focused on the following topics: Economics and Marketing; Production and Breeding; Post Harvest Handling; Aflatoxin; Nutrition, Allergy, and Functional Foods; and Peanut Utilization.

The scientific program consists of plenary sessions featuring special keynote lectures by invited world renowned scientist speakers. In addition, ample time is also provided for poster presentations which will allow displaying throughout the Conference. Moreover, one day technical tour is arranged to visit Peanut Production at the Suwan Research Farm, Kasetsart University, and sight seeing at the National Agricultural Museum.

Objective

The objective of the Conference was to provide scientists, technologists and extension and industry personnel who are interested in production, post-harvest handling, product and process development, economic, marketing, food safety, quality of peanuts, nutrition and health to share their knowledge in each specialized areas and learn from each other.

Financial Assistance and Organization

Peanut Collaborative Research Support Program, United States Agency for International Development, and Kasetsart University, funded the International Peanut Conference. Another source of finance was the attendance registration fee from attendees.

Course Participants

One hundred and fifty participants from 18 countries attended the Conference. A half of all participants (75 participants) were international participants and the rest were local participants. Most of participants were male. Participants were classified as shown in Table 1. Address, email, telephone number, gender of participants is shown in Appendix 1.

There were 82 participants going to the National Agricultural Museum and Suwan Wajokkasikit Field Crops Research Station (Suwan Research Farm) on the Tour day. List of participants who attended this tour is shown in Appendix 2. Participants seemed enjoyed the tour. The Golden Jubilee Agricultural Museum commemorates the 50-year reign of King Bhumibol Adulyadej, the agricultural monarch. A strong underlying theme of King Bhumibol's rule has been his concern for the welfare of the poor, small farmer that has for generations comprised the majority of the Thai population. Suwan Research Farm is responsible for research and render services and facilities for researchers who work on corn and sorghum and other related crops. The center also carries out specific research projects urgently needed of the country. Participants visited the peanut production field. Also, they visited the temple and grape filed crop which were located nearby the Suwan Research Farm.

There were posters to present at the Conference. The summaries of each poster were published in the Summary book of the International Peanut Conference 2005. List of titles of posters are shown in Table 3. There were 54 posters under the topic of Production and Breeding Technologies, 10 posters under the topic of Postharvest Handling and Aflatoxin, 14 posters for Marketing and Utilization, and 5 posters for Nutrition and Health topic.

Resource Persons

The committees of the Conference, who are regularly lectured for university courses and currently involved in peanut research as resource persons, were invited from many eminent Universities such as Kasetsart University, Thailand; Khon Kaen University, Thailand, and University of Georgia, USA to be Intenational Advisory Committee, Scientific Committee and Working Committee. Also, well-know scientists from Department of Agriculture were cooperating as working Committees. Additionally, some researchers from Kasetsart Agricultural Product Improvement Institute were invited to work in the part of working committees. List of resource persons, supporting staff, graduate students and technicians are shown in the Appendix 4.

Publication

The fist circulars were published and distributed to participants with having brief details of the Conference such as objective, conference venue, registration fee, accommodation, contact address, Reply Form, etc.

The second or final circulars with having more details of the Conference such as objective, conference venue, registration fee, information of Bangkok, Registration Form, Hotel Reservation Form, Paper Form, etc, were published and distributed to participant both who replied the form of first circular and who were new.

The summary books for the Conference were published in English language with 164 pages which was having cover, schedule program table, preface by Associate Professor. Vichai Haruthaithanasan, a chairman of the

conference, conference program, content, lecture notes from speakers in the part of plenary session, summaries of paper for poster presentation session, list of participants and list of committee.

3. Registration

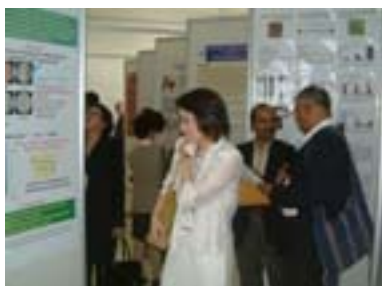
